MEDICAL AND DENTAL PROFESSIONALS' REGISTRATION AND LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

The Grenada Medical and Dental Council (GMDC) welcomes applications for registration as a medical or dental practitioner in Grenada. The Council promotes quality health care for the citizens of Grenada, Carriacou and Petit Martinique, and thanks you for your interest in working to achieve this objective.

In order to be registered in Grenada, GMDC requires the following pieces of documentation.

We appreciate your patience, understanding and cooperation as you complete this stage of the process.

Documents Required

Identification

- Two Passport Sized photographs
- Curriculum Vitae (Resumé)

Education and Competencies

- Notarized copy of Medical Degree, Diploma, Course Certificates and Post-Graduate Degree.
- Statement of Verification of MD Degree or equivalent from <u>Grenada National Accreditation</u> <u>Board</u>.
- Notarized copy of current Medical Registration and Notarized copy of current Medical Practicing License (if applicable)
- Evidence to prove competency in English Language, both verbal and writing skills (Non-English-speaking natives only)

Referees

- Two letters of professional references
- Letter of Good Standing from Current Medical Registration Board¹
- Medical Certification of fitness to work.

Insurance

- Evidence of indemnity coverage applicable in Grenada².
- All copies of Mal-practice Insurance coverage must be notarized.

NB: All documents must be in English or translated by a registered public interpreter and certified by a Notary Public

- ¹A letter stating that no medical legal action has been taken or is pending against the applicant.
- ²Not applicable for doctors who provide voluntary services duly authorized and supervised by the Government for the duration of a project and sponsored by Civil Service Organization, Faith-based Organizations.
